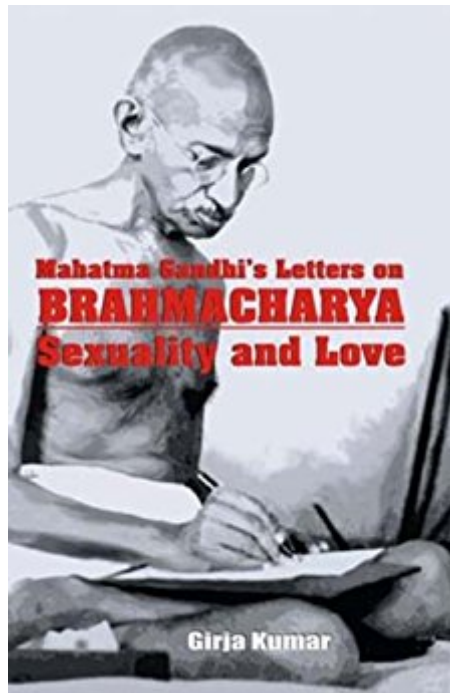

Finally, Gandhiji comes out as a contemporary as well as the timeless mahapurush.
