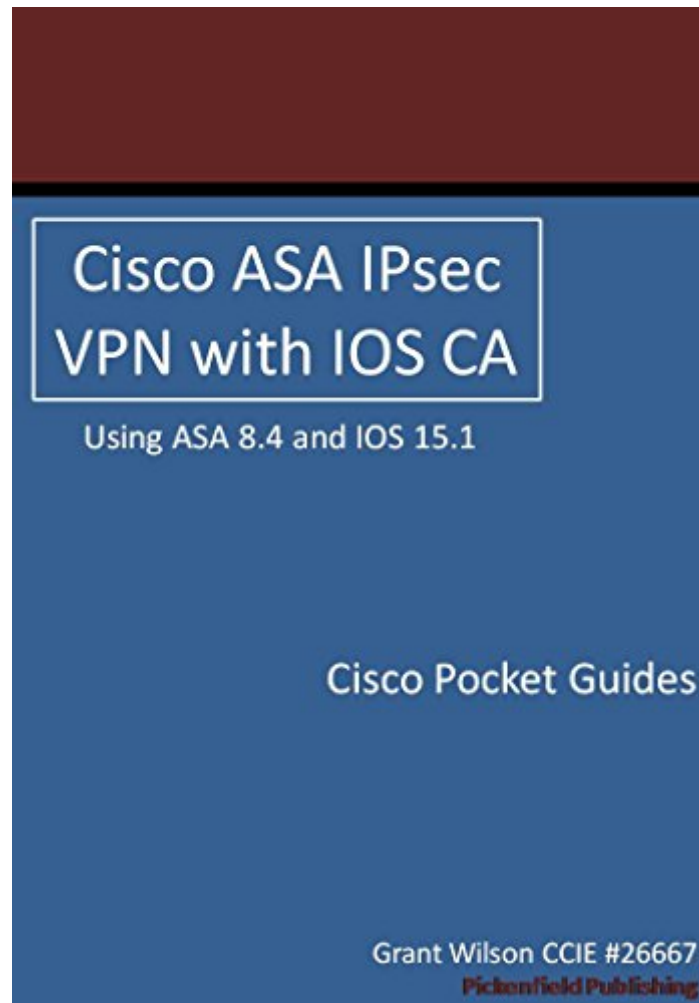

Cisco ASA IPsec VPN With IOS CA (Cisco Pocket Guides Book 3)



Synopsis

This book discusses how to connect your company sites together using a LAN to LAN IPsec VPN using Cisco ASA firewalls. It will be using the latest IPsec features like IKE v2 and SHA 3 and also discussing using a Cisco router as a certificate authority (IOSCA). There will be two IPsec setups, one using pre-shared keys and the other using digital certificates. This book is designed so that you could use it as a guide to build your own lab and configure the features discussed. I will be using the ASA CLI and not the ASDM in this book as it is easier to use and more powerful. The ASDM is very useful for management after the ASA has been configured. The ASA will be based upon a 5510 with version 8.4 but a lot of the configuration will work on previous versions of the code and on other platforms except NAT. The reason for this is that NAT completely changed from version 8.3 onwards.
